Dear Hilton Central School Resident,

The Hilton Central School District faced challenging decisions when developing the 2010-11 budget with the goal of continuing to strive for high quality education that is affordable to the community. To accomplish this goal, difficult reductions were unavoidable.

Transportation for our students was not exempt from the need for budget reductions. The adopted budget for 2010-11 includes a reduction in the number of bus stops. The following changes to procedures were included in the student bus stop schedules for the 2010-11 school year:

- All students are required to walk to and from the designated bus stops.
- A designated bus stop may be located at a residence with the priority of stopping at the youngest student's home in the immediate area.
- A 100 ft. walking distance up to and from the bus stop has been established for students in Kindergarten – Grade 6, and up to an 800 ft. walking distance has been designated for students in Grades 7 – 12.
- Buses transporting students in Grades 7 – 12 will not travel on cul-de-sacs.
- Special Education students need to have door to door transportation stated on their individual education plan (IEP) in order to receive the service.

Safe transportation of students continues to be a priority in the Hilton Central School District, and these changes meet the state laws and regulations pertaining to student transportation for public schools.
